

Placement Test for Adventures in Language® I (2014 Edition)

Students need to be at least at Lesson 91 of Reading Mastery 1, or at a mid-grade one reading level, to be successful in Adventures in Language® Level I.

Students need to be able to copy a sentence that is 7 words in length. The sentence should be printed on a sheet of paper, with lines directly under the sentence. The students should copy the sentence onto the lines. The sentence should be copied within a reasonable amount of time (2-3 minutes).

Sentence to copy:

The pigs had fun in the mud.

Scoring:

If a student cannot copy the sentence within the specified time limit, this level of the program may be too difficult. Administer the placement test for Language for Learning (SRA).

If a student has the required reading level, and is able to copy the sentence within the specified amount of time, he or she is correctly placed in this level of the program.

You're interested in the student's ability to produce print. Do not penalize the student for omitting the capital letter or the period.

Recommendation:

It is best to use Adventures in Language® I with students who are in Grade 1 or higher.
